Rosser Award nominations welcome

Nominations are welcomed for the fourth annual Alan C. Rosser Character Award. This award is granted to a graduating senior at Anderson High School who has through the course of his or her athletic endeavors demonstrated the same attributes of character that the late Alan "Chip" Rosser exemplified. The award will be presented at the awards ceremony for seniors at the end of May and includes a \$2000 scholarship.

Chip Rosser, a longtime supporter of Anderson High School and Anderson youth athletics, died unexpectedly three years ago. Both on and off the field of play, he encouraged respect for self and others, good sportsmanship, integrity and fairmindedness, a focus on the goals of the team over individual glory, and making the individual effort to "be the best that you can be." The Rosser Award was established by Alan Rosser's partners at the law firm of Strauss & Troy and Terry S. Jacobs in order to encourage others to continue to embrace these goals.

Nominations are being accepted until May 7, 2004 for the Class of 2007 Rosser Award.
